

TRAINEESHIPS WITHIN THE EPP GROUP

The EPP Parliamentary Group in the European Parliament offers young graduates the possibility of doing a traineeship with its Secretariat in Brussels.

Applicants must have:

- an officially recognised higher education degree, and
- an excellent knowledge of at least two official EU languages (their mother tongue and one other language, preferably French or English).

The traineeship lasts for a maximum of three months. There are at most 10 trainees per three-month period.

Each trainee will be supervised by an administrator from the EPP Group Secretariat. The traineeship content must be agreed in advance with the supervising administrator and the trainee must submit a written report at the end of the traineeship.

A payment of up to EUR 1000.00 per month is made to cover living costs in Brussels, plus travel and accommodation costs to attend a session in Strasbourg along with basic insurance.

How to apply:

Applicants must send in an EPP Group application form, duly completed and signed, with a motivation letter and copies of their degree certificate and supporting evidence of linguistic knowledge, enclosing a letter of recommendation from a national or European political figure who is a member of the EPP family of parties, plus a university reference. The traineeship should preferably follow shortly after studies finished.
